



## HOW TO ENTER THE CONTEST:

Entrants have the opportunity to enter the Contest by visiting (the “[www.earthforeveryone.org](http://www.earthforeveryone.org)”). At the Website, entrants must follow the entry links and instructions to complete the Contest registration form. The registration form will require an Entrant to enter the following information: Full name, complete mailing address, membership code\*, phone number, and email address. In addition, each Entrant must submit a photo pertaining to wildlife (the “Theme”). Submission of a Theme-applicable photo is a mandatory step of Contest Entry.

Submitted photos must contain wildlife, including but not limited to mammals, invertebrates, birds, fish, marine wildlife, insects, and reptiles. Submitted photos may contain people, as long as non-human wildlife is present in the photo. Submitted photos should depict animals in their natural habitat. Please, do not submit photos of animals in captivity. Each successfully completed registration form and Theme-applicable photo submission will result in one (1) Contest entry. EFE has the right to not accept/approve submissions deemed inappropriate or not Theme-applicable. Limit three (3) separate photo submissions/entries per person for members and one for others.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS:

Once submitted, an entry cannot be deleted, canceled or modified, unless approved by the Sponsor(EFE). The Entrant is responsible for all costs associated with uploading the photo. In the event that more than one of the same photo is submitted, only the first submission received shall be accepted. In order to be eligible, entries must actually be received by the Sponsor during the Submission Period. Entries received by the Sponsor before the start of the Submission Period or after the end of the Submission Period are VOID. Proof of submitting a Contest entry form or photo will not be deemed by Sponsor to constitute proof of actual receipt by Sponsor of an entry. Those who do not follow all of the instructions, do not provide the required information in their entry form, or do not abide by these Official Rules or other instructions of Sponsor may be disqualified. Your submission of an entry constitutes your representation of eligibility, consent to participate in Contest and consent for Sponsor to obtain, use, and transfer your name, contact information, photo and other information for the purpose of Contest administration.

By submitting an entry, each Entrant: 1) will retain the copyright of the Entrant's submitted photos at all times (Sponsor will never own the copyright to Entrant's photos); 2) irrevocably grants Sponsor a royalty-free non-exclusive license throughout the world to use, re-use, copy, publish, republish in whole or in part, edit, add to, modify, and rearrange the entry in whatever media, including without limitation edit, rearrange, and/or copy the entry for use in the Contest of Sponsor's products and services, without further permission, consideration or payment to the Entrant, except where prohibited; 3) warrants and represents that the Entry is entirely the original creation/work of the Entrant and that use of the Entry as described herein will not violate any law or infringe upon the rights, title, claim or interest of any third party; and 4) certify that Entrant is the creator and sole copyright owner of the Entry.

## Full Terms & Conditions

The Earth For Everyone(EFE) Photo Contest Series 2017 is now open for entries. Before you enter, please read the competition terms and conditions below.

*Specific entry requirements related to file preparation and digital adjustment guidelines can be found on the entry upload page.*

### General

1. This Photography Contests series (“the competition”) is owned by EFE, an organization based in Sweden.
2. By submitting an entry to the competition, you acknowledge that you have read and agree to be bound by these rules and the decisions of EFE, and that you satisfy all eligibility requirements.
3. Any entry found not to comply with the competition rules will be disqualified.
4. No allowances will be made in such instances and any prizes will be forfeited.
5. The decision of EFE on all matters relating to the competition is final. No negotiation will be considered.
6. The competition is not open to board members and their relatives.

### Judging

1. The winners and highly commended entries will be selected by well noun international judges, their name will be published after photo contest is closed.
2. All entries will be judged anonymously.
3. Awarded images in each category will comprise Winner, Runners-up and Highly Commended.

### Ethics

1. Entrants must not compromise the welfare of any animals, and should never do anything to injure or distress any animals or destroy their habitat in an attempt to secure an image.
2. Entrants are responsible for ensuring full compliance with any national or international legislation governing of Iran and in securing any relevant permits which may be required.
3. Descriptive captions supplied must be accurate and honest.



## Prizes

1. Entrants who have awarded image(s) will be notified by email in Jun 2017.
2. EFE cannot be held responsible for emails that do not arrive due to an entrant's email security settings.
3. Prizes specified on the main contest page are guaranteed to be awarded.

## Copyright and Reproduction

1. Each entry must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party.
2. Each entrant must either be the sole owner of the copyright or have secured the written permission of the copyright owner to enter the image into the competition and grants the EFE the rights detailed below.
3. By entering the competition, each shortlisted entrant grants to EFE to reproduce, publish and communicate to the public by any means and exhibit their image(s) and copies of their image(s) in all media throughout the world in relation to the competition and rising awareness of wildlife situation in Iran, including but not limited to all use in the context of:
  - Display in any other exhibition.
  - Inclusion within EFE and related websites, social media and newsletters.
  - Inclusion in promotional, press and marketing materials associated with the competition series and/or the exhibition.
4. Any external parties featuring images from the competition reserve the right to choose which images they decide to use to promote the competition. EFE has no control over, or liability for, any decision such press may make to use (or not use) your image.

## Publicity

1. All entrants agree that if their entry is awarded, their name and likeness may be used for the purposes of advertising, promotion and publicity of the competition and exhibition without further compensation.



## Liability

1. EFE cannot accept liability for any loss or damage of any image entered into the competition however caused.
2. EFE cannot accept liability for the misuse of images and/or failure of any third party to comply with the competition's credit guidelines.
